- A Godparent has to be suited to and intend to fulfil the responsibilities of the role. He or she must be at least sixteen years old and "be a Catholic who has been confirmed, and has received the Blessed Eucharist, and who lives a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken" (Canon 874).
- The child's parent may not act as a Godparent.
- Compulsory baptism preparatory session for Parents & Godparents.
- *A baptised person who is a practising member of a non-Catholic ecclesial community may be admitted only in the company with a Catholic Godparent and is known as a 'Christian Witness'.
- Parents are encouraged to make donations to the Church and Minister.
