MASS INTENTIONS

What is a Mass Intention? At each Mass the Priest will pray for the Intention being offered. It may be for someone who has died, for someone who has an exam or is starting a new job. Any situation at all where we wish to ask God to support someone with His strength or His love Normally people make a donation along with the Intention, the original purpose of this was to ensure that the priest would be able to eat that day! Although this is no longer needed, the offering is generally made where people can afford it. If you cannot afford a donation this should not put you off wanting a Mass to be offered for any particular intention.

BLESSED GIUSEPPE "PINO" PUGLISI A Saint of our time

Fr Puglisi was a native of Palermo in Sicily and ministered in a rough and run-down neighbourhood of that city. In his outreach to many of the young people who lived in his parish he sought to teach them that, in the words of St John Bosco, virtue is beautiful and sin ugly. His success in this work brought him into conflict with the local Mafia, who saw that by giving many of those who were poor something to hope in he was drawing them away from the Mafia. He received threats, but his response was not only to continue his work but to denounce the Mafia from the pulpit. Then on his 56th birthday, 15 September 1993, he was gunned down outside his home by the Mafia. He was beatified on 15 May 2013. His life and work in Palermo has been made into a film (Come Into the Light) starring Luca Zingaretti (known to many as Inspector Montalbano)
