EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF THE EUCHARIST

It is intended that we should go back to offering Communion under both kinds at Sunday Masses. This of course means that we need to build up again a team of Extraordinary Ministers to assist in the giving of Communion. There may be some who have previously served in this ministry who would be happy to take it up again. It may be that there are 'new' people who would be pleased to serve.

To be an Extraordinary Minister (the ordained clergy are the 'Ordinary' Ministers) it is necessary that one should be Confirmed in the Catholic Church, that one should be regularly at Sunday Mass and that one should be living in accordance with the Marriage Laws of the Catholic Church. As for being worthy – don't worry, you're not, I'm not! But it is work of service in the Catholic community.

If you think the Lord might be calling you to this work, please have a word with me or Fr Alessandro.
