MARCH FOR LIFE UK The March for Life UK will take place on Saturday, 6 September. This year's theme is 'Human Rights for All Humans' Abortion denies the most vulnerable their most basic right – the right to life. This family friendly event unites thousands in recognising the value of life from the moment of conception onward, and standing up for all affected by abortion. There will be a Mass at Westminster Cathedral at 10.30am and the March begins at 1.00pm at the Emmanuel Centre, Marsham Street, SW1P 3NT.

SAFEGUARDING The CSSA (Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency) has launched a public survey as part of its thematic inspection on survivor engagement and support. Victims and survivors of abuse – recent or historic – are invited to share their experiences of contact with dioceses and Religious Life Groups.

In Northampton, we continue to walk alongside survivors through initiatives such as the Healing Garden at the Cathedral and Bishop David's *A Time to Listen*. We encourage survivors to participate in the survey, helping shape a safer Church for all.
