NOVEMBER – Month of the Holy Souls The month of November is the time when we especially pray for those who have gone ahead of us on their journey to God. Through this prayer we help the Holy Souls to grow in perfection and remind ourselves that the parting of death is not for ever.

It is a good custom to write the names of those one wishes to be prayed for on a paper and place it in an envelope. All the envelopes will be placed on the altar throughout November and those remembered will be collectively brought before God at every Mass.

Envelopes are available at the church entrance. Place your list of names, together with any offering you may be making, in the envelope which may then be placed in the ordinary collection.

MORNING PRAYER For any who wish to participate in the Morning Prayer of the Church, offered at St Augustine's most mornings Monday to Friday, we use the 'Universalis' app which you can put on your smartphones on the settings for Northampton Diocese.

NIGHT SHELTER The Upper Room will be used as a WHC Night Shelter venue on Wednesday nights from January to March.
