PRO-LIFE NEWS Recently the Assembly of the Principality of Monaco voted to pass a bill liberalising the abortion laws in Monaco. Among the proposals was that parental consent was not needed in the case of 15 year olds. Although the bill passed the Assembly Prince Albert refused to sign it, thus it can not become law. His refusal was partly based on the argument that such a law would go against the Catholic foundation and tradition of the Principality.
