Bishops' Statement – The Catholic Church continues to oppose assisted suicide and calls for compassionate care, dignity and support at the end of life. The Bill returns to Parliament on **11 September**. The Bishops encourage Catholics to read their statement and, where appropriate, contact their MP to register their opposition.
